BRAZIL'S SPIRITUAL NEED

Only 800 million of the world's population live below the equator with a guarter of them living in Brazil! To put that in comparison, Chile has over 17 million people who need the gospel. However, the country is less than the population of Brazil's largest city which has over 20 million people - São Paulo. You would need to send 12 missionaries to Brazil for every 1 missionary you would send to Chili to reach the same amount of people!





FOREIGN MISSIONARY SITUATION

Though Brazil has had many missionaries over the years, since the 1990s, the number of missionaries there has been dropping. One Baptist missions agency reported they have 45% less now than they did in the 1990s. Furthermore, most missionaries in Brazil are at or past retirement age.




NATIONAL PASTORS SITUATION


