Testimony of Salvation and Call into Christian Service

Mike Schmidt:

At age 9, my mother led me in the sinners prayer, yet we never went to church growing up. At the age of 16, I got connected to a youth group and began going on my own. After I came back from summer camp, I sat through a church service and was miserable. One of the workers noticed and asked me afterward if I was sure I was saved. I told him no, and right there I asked Christ to save me from my sin, and was baptized two weeks later.

Every once in a while my youth pastor would let the teens preach during Sunday school. One of the times he challenged us guys to make a message, i took him up on it. While sitting working on a message, it became clear to me that this was what I was to do with my life- that is to preach. I surrendered to go to Bible College and did so the next year. For the past 15 years I have served the Lord in whatever way I could. For the last eight years I've served as youth pastor at South Knollwood Baptist Church. Along with working with the youth, I've also operated in many other capacities. Some of them include electrical, plumbing, construction, inventory, outreach, website design, graphic design and pulpit fill.

I have always been open to missions, but never felt God leading and directing me that way until this year. In July of 2018, we took a missions trip to Itapua do Oeste, Brazil. It was on a Monday morning when I woke up and, as when I was called to preach, it was clear that I was to be there in Brazil. After three days, I talked with my pastor, and we decided to take a couple of months to pray. During those months, God made it clear to me that missions was still His will. There were providential meetings and conversations, the continued promptings from the Spirit, and the confirmation of my spiritual mentors- especially that of my pastor. It was in fact made so plain to me that, I am without question, convinced I will be sinning if I do not go.



Testimony of Salvation and Call into Christian Service

Ashlie Schmidt:

I asked Jesus to save me from my sins at the age of nine at vacation bible school. After that event in my life, I didn't attend church except for your occasional Christmas or Easter service. The lack of God's Word in my life was evident in my teen years as I began heading down a scary path of living.

Many nights, I remembered praying, asking God to help me stop sinning so much. Not understanding that he already did when He died and rose again. Finally one day when I was 18, it was like something knocked me aside the head and said Ashlie, go back to your "home" church. I told my friend that I was going to go to church that Sunday because I needed to stop living the way I was-drugs, bad relationships, lying, stealing, and so much more. I cannot remember if it was that night or another but I remember being in my room as an 18 year girl pleading to God for forgiveness for the way my life was at the time. I remembered as I thought on what Christ did on the cross so that I might be forgiven for the horrible things I had done, my heart was overjoyed with the truth that I could be pardoned. That moment was such a refreshing, liberating time in my life. I felt so clean and so loved that I couldn't help but give everything to Him. I started out attending Trinity Baptist in Jacksonville FL. Then two years later, transferred to Heartland Baptist Bible College. It was there that I met my husband and we married soon after graduation.

In the summer of 2018 on our missions trip to Brazil, the Lord began to work on the heart of my husband to surrender to come back to Brazil. I am excited for what lies ahead. Though the heartache of leaving has been far greater than I ever could imagine, I know Gods will for my life is to submit to the leadership of my husband and trust that God is in control. I am more than ready to serve the people in Brazil and love them just like I love the people here in the States.
